## *A Foundation for Employment*



### Course Overview

This Web-based course begins January 13, 2003, and spans 12 weeks. Each two-week lesson will provide practical information that will be immediately applicable in the supported employment setting. Topics include: job development, training supports, organizational supports, social supports, physical support, and community and family supports. The purpose of the course is to coordinate the support needs of the individual in relation to the employment setting.
