Workshop Overview

This interactive, one-day workshop focuses on the vocational implications of persons who are dually diagnosed with mental illness and substance abuse. Topics include the changing nature of work and how it impacts persons with dual diagnosis, the DSM-IV 5 axis diagnosis model, substance abuse and substance dependence, and common mental disorders dually diagnosed with substance abuse and dependence. Goals and objectives upon workshop completion include:

- Participants will be able to identify and distinguish symptoms of substance dependence using case studies and DSM-IV diagnostic criteria.
- Participants will be able to identify the symptoms of substance abuse and dependence that are most relevant to workplace problems.

- Participants will be able to identify symptoms of the psychiatric illnesses that are frequently diagnosed with substance abuse, including depression, anxiety disorders, and schizophrenia.
- Participants will be able to implement strategies to facilitate improved work outcomes for persons dually diagnosed with a psychiatric disorder and substance dependence.

Presenters

Dr. David Strauser is an Associate Professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Community Health at the University of Illinois. He has over ten years experience as a rehabilitation educator and researcher and extensive experience in working with people with disabilities. He has provided consultation to community-based rehabilitation and mental health programs in the area of career development and employment of individuals with disabilities. He has published in national and international journals and has presented at regional, national, and international conferences. He is currently serving as co-editor of the *Journal of Rehabilitation* and serves on the editorial board of *Rehabilitation Counseling Bulletin*, *Rehabilitation Education*, and *Rehabilitation Psychology*.

Deirdre O'Sullivan is a doctoral student and teaching assistant in the Department of Kinesiology and Community Health at the University of Illinois. She has a Master's Degree in Rehabilitation Counseling and has experience counseling individuals with disabilities in community rehabilitation settings. She has presented at national conferences and is a member of the American Counseling Association and National Rehabilitation Association. Her research has focused on the impact of the counseling relationship on rehabilitation outcomes.
