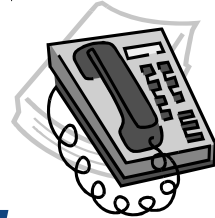

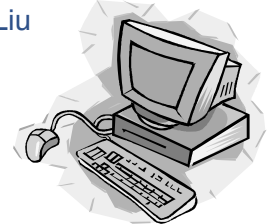

Best practices for functional assessment, job development, job placement, and related issues will be discussed. Person-centered planning is a process-oriented approach to empowering people with disabilities. The process focuses on individuals' needs and puts them in charge of defining the direction of their life. You will learn strategies on how to promote person-centered planning and hear many examples of how to instill this philosophy and "way of doing business" with the individuals with whom you are working.
